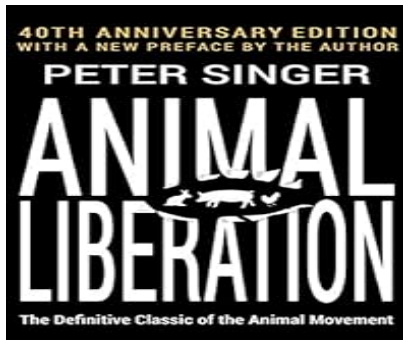

Peter Singer is sometimes called the world's most influential living philosopher although he thinks that if that is true it doesn't say much for all the other living philosophers around today. He has also been called the father (or grandfather?) of the modern animal rights movement even though he doesn't base his philosophical views on rights either for humans or for animals.) He is known especially for his work on the ethics of our treatment of animals for his controversial critique of the sanctity of life doctrine in bioethics and for his writings on the obligations of the affluent to aid those living in extreme poverty. DeCamp Professor of Bioethics in the University Center for Human Values at Princeton University: Since 2005 he has combined that position with the position of Laureate Professor at the University of Melbourne in the School of Historical and Philosophical Studies. In 2012 he was made a Companion of the Order of Australia the nation's highest civic honour[1]
