Was Einstein's first wife his uncredited coauthor unpaid assistant or his unacknowledged helpmeet? The real "Mileva Story. **Einstein wife cousin** Some of the tellers of the "Mileva Story" made startling claims: that she was a brilliant mathematician who surpassed her husband and that she made uncredited contributions to his most celebrated papers in 1905 including his paper on special relativity. **Einstein wife cousin** Mileva's ambitions for a science career however suffered a series of setbacks—failed diploma examinations a disagreement with her doctoral dissertation adviser an out of wedlock pregnancy by Einstein. **Book about albert einstein's wife** Was Mileva her husband's uncredited coauthor unpaid assistant or his essential helpmeet? It's tempting to believe that she was her husband's secret collaborator but the authors of Einstein's Wife look at the actual evidence scrutinizing sources even scouring historical records such as Albert and Mileva's school grades. **Einstein's wife name** But as later biographers fill in the details it bugs Esterson to no end that Maric's cousin Tima Goric told one historian about Mileva and Einstein's late night working sessions but didn't tell it to Trbuhovic Gjuric. **Book einstein's wife** To Esterson both things couldn't possibly be true; the rest of us know better! Even when there's documented evidence of her hand written notes among Albert's university lectures he points out that Einstein's letters make no mention of Mileva's effort. **Einstein's wife theory of relativity** What a pity the Great Man didn't document his life with greater historical rigor! Other historians might value first second or third hand oral accounts but like a litigator Esterson dismisses these as hearsay. **Einstein's wife book** 0262039613 easy read 0262039613 I give the book (pretentiously subtitled The Real Story of Mileva Einstein Maric) 2 stars because of the fairly sympathetic portrait that David Cassidy paints of Mileva Maric the first wife of Albert Einstein and the alleged (in the authors' view) contributor to his famous theories. **Einstein wife rules** His favorite expressions among many in rejecting such claims by a wide variety of people are "without any sources" "non evidence" "historical nonsense" "numerous factual errors" "demonstrably false" "utterly unreliable" etc. **Einstein wife was his cousin** Quite a stretch and certainly in the spirit of the "nonsense" he attributes to others and definitely "unreferenced and unsubstantiated" as he describes the claims of Peter Michel who is sympathetic to Mileva. **Einstein's wife mileva** Cosmology as religion has captured the narrative so that hyperbole concerning Einstein and relativity is everywhere: Einstein as man of the century Einstein as genius (what percentage of the people who use that word to describe him actually know what he did?) special and general relativity as the greatest discoveries ever in the history of science (special relativity: "It stands as one of the greatest intellectual achievements in the history of human thought" (Cosmology P Coles [2001 14]). **Book einstein's wife** So the paper on special relativity in 1905 did not have a single citation or reference ("without any sources at all" the expression Esterson uses to describe Krstić's account of Einstein and Mileva working together in science). **Einstein wife cousin** The authors do not include in their bibliography or discuss Ohanian's Einstein's Mistakes Bjerknæs' Einstein's Partner in Crime or Schlafly's How Einstein Ruined Physics all of which would have dispelled the idea of an infallible high priest. **Einstein wife cousin** No mention also of the Wikipedia article "The Relativity Priority Dispute" which examines in detail the claims of priority and plagiarism in the foundations of relativity including Mileva Maric's possible role in it. **Book einstein's wife** The less than seven pages by Ruth Lewin Sime on Women in Science did not fit the tone of the other sections of the book and was clearly a weak attempt at pretending this book presents a balanced argument:

Einstein's wife name "Albert Einstein's first wife Mileva Einstein Maric was forgotten for decades, **Book about albert einstein's wife** When a trove of correspondence between them beginning in their student days was discovered in 1986 her story began to be told: **Einstein's wife documentary** This book based on extensive historical research uncovers the real "Mileva Story, **Book about albert einstein's wife** " Mileva was one of the few women of her era to pursue higher education in science; she and Einstein were students together at the Zurich Polytechnic: **Einstein's wife theory of relativity** She and Einstein married in 1903 and had two sons but the marriage failed, **Einstein wife rules** The result should have been a compelling corrective to the very probably inflated claims made on Mileva's behalf, **Book einstein's wife** But Esterson has an axe to grind and the hatchet job he does on Mileva and her defenders in this exasperating ultimately frustrating book turns his analysis into parody. **Einstein wife cousin** This isn't readable narrative history; it's a blow by blow attack on Maric's ventriloquists and it turns out he's no less a propagandist. **Einstein's wife did the work** There's no detail he spares from casting his aspersions doubts or shadows, **Book about albert einstein's wife** He accuses his opponents of extraordinary presumptions while proposing some whoppers of his own imagining: **Einstein's wife documentary** Desanka Trbuhovic Gjuric the earliest biographer on the scene is taken to task for her shoddy source attributions, **Einstein's wife was the genius** To Esterson that's evidence that it didn't happen when it might just be evidence that T G didn't ask the right questions: **Einstein's wife's name** He finds it highly suspect that Mileva could assist her husband with his papers and simultaneously complain to a friend that her husband spends too much time on his science. **Einstein's wife book** With Queeg like obsession Esterson is determined to prove that Maric filched the strawberries but only succeeds in demonstrating that it's possible to protest too much, **Book about albert einstein's wife** Somewhere between the boosterism of the Mileva camp and Esterson's character assassination there has to be a Third Way. **Einstein's wife's name** As for my copy of this book it may make a fine grocery bag after I recycle the pages, **Einstein's wife was the genius** She had a hard time for several reasons and that is brought out sympathetically in the book. **Einstein's wife did the work** But the purpose of the book: if she did help Einstein how much credit should she get? In their view almost none: **Einstein's wife documentary** As the myth has it Einstein did it all my himself all out of his own head. **Einstein wife cousin** More than half the book (Allen Esterson) is a professional hatchet job "proving" that Mileva Maric could not possibly have made any significant contributions to Einstein's theories, **Einstein wife cousin** However Esterson has a real problem with the letters Einstein wrote to Mileva (see Albert Einstein Mileva Maric: The Love Letters Princeton 1992).

Einstein's wife book What is most intriguing about these letters is the number of times Einstein refers to "our" in his scientific work: **Einstein's wives names** He has never acknowledged Mileva's help but I don't know how anyone can avoid the conclusion that she was a collaborator during the critical period leading up to 1905, **Book about albert einstein's wife** 39); "Don't [Mileva] forget to check on the extent to which glass conforms to the Dulong Petit law, **Book about albert einstein's wife** How does Esterson avoid the obvious meaning of these sentences? "Einstein's concern for her at this time it has been argued (e. **Einstein's wife book** by Pais [1994 8]) led to his using expressions such as 'our work' and 'our paper' in order to help her emotionally by drawing her into his own researches" (143 144). **Einstein's wife did the work** If cosmology is a substitute for

(p. 40); " .our theory of molecular forces ." (p. 45); " . enough empirical material for our investigation . "(p. 47); and "I gave him our paper" (p. 52). There are other references too.g. Hmmm.
