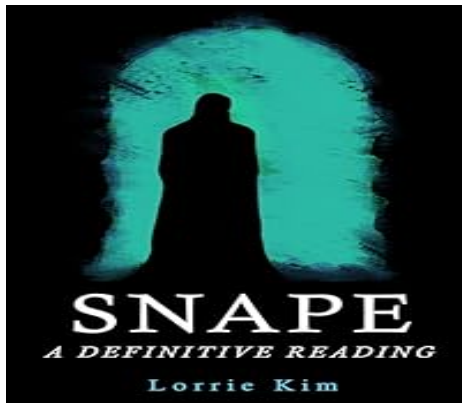

So when a friend recommended this book to me I had no choice but to read it and I must say I don't regret it. This book is not only a deep dive into Snape's very own mind and soul but it also shows that Lorrie Kim knows her way with words: For anybody who's still unsure about buying it the book's structure is as follows: Every chapter takes a closer look on each Harry Potter book, There are lots of quotes from pretty much all scenes that Snape appears in and also from scenes where he is mentioned (even if not always directly). She points out a lot of things that I hadn't realised up until reading her book and I've read all Harry Potter books very often and thoroughly. And some parts of the HP books have

to be read than once and not in a 'HP I read all 7 books at once all over again' binge reading session and really carefully. But who does that? Most of us are probably not capable of it or not interested, She noticed all the small things and made me reflect them a little. However Lorrie Kim has opened my eyes to of this character I hadn't considered or realised, 978-1940699134 It is a really amazing try to analyze every single aspect of Snape's Personality and actions.
