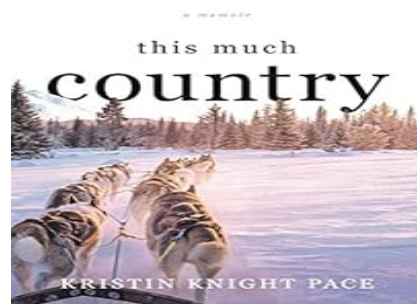


This Much Country By Kristin Knight Pace
