Being queer himself TJ believes its important—now than ever—to have accurate positive Middle Earth etc etc) a parade of individually charming characters and a romance that has you laughing as much as sighing wistfully then you'll enjoy this. I took it on holiday with me and I could be heard laughing out loud on the plane; by the pool; in my room! TJ Klune has taken a motley crew and made them adorable. Our unlikely hero the apprentice Wizard Sam of Wilds is cute and brave and reckless and horny; ALL the time! He speaks before he thinks but he is fiercely loyal and loves hard. His best friend Gary is a hornless unicorn with the mouth and morals of a diva drag queen and their friend and protector Tiggy Sam who is a wizard's apprentice at the beginning of the book he and Gary (best friend and gay unicorn) are captured and then saved by their other best friend Tiggy the half giant. LGBTQ+ rep (gay main characters and asexual side character)What I loved (and at times hated) was the fact that nothing phases our main character this is such a humorous story and I could not stop laughing throughout! However at times I felt like I needed a bit seriousness a bit emotion. For one thing all (I think?) the main characters bar the king and Sam's parents — who actually get to live with him in the castle when he's taken on as a wizard's apprentice not just one but both of them we have a non orphan hero OMG — are queer. Another thing I loved sort of related to the queerness was how The Lightning Struck Heart uses so many of the tried and true high fantasy tropes sometimes with a bit of a twist but rather shamelessly.comI don't like Ryan very much so every time someone mentioned something unkind he'd done and he had to apologise I smirked. There are some properly funny parts of this book that made me laugh out loud, There are also A LOT of weak jokes and monotonous banter that could have been cut as they were just distracting and took the focus off the better jokes, Offrir cet ebook This book is quite unlike any other of its sort: If you're looking for high fantasy (Think Discworld.

Is a half giant determined to 'smash' whatever threatens Sam or Gary, The three of them embark on a series of adventures and the characters they meet and the situations they find themselves in are absolutely hysterical: The love interest comes in the visually delicious form of Ryan; a brave knight bequeathed to the Prince, It's all a bit messy but utterly delightful and the way things pan out is genius, I have read a lot of this author's work and he seems to get better and better with each new release. Of course this catches the attention of a higher power and Sam's pulled from the only world he knows to become an apprentice to the king's wizard Morgan of Shadows: When Sam's 14 he

enters the Dark Woods and returns with Gary the hornless gay unicorn and a half giant named Tiggy earning the moniker Sam of Wilds: At 15 Sam learns what love truly is when a new knight arrives at the castle Knight Ryan Foxheart the dreamiest dream to have ever been dreamed, Offrir cet ebook TJ KLUNE is a Lambda Literary Award winning author (Into This River I Drown) and an ex claims examiner for an insurance company, His novels include the Green Creek series The House on the Cerulean Sea and The Extraordinaries, Now to be totally honest I'd avoided this book for a while despite having seen good reviews: The summary had me scratching my head and deciding it probably wasn't for me, Word of warning: If you're used to super serious romances that get straight to the 'point' in ways than one then this might challenge you. I however was delightfully surprised by the breath of fresh air that is TJ Klune's brand of humour in 'The Lightning Struck Heart'. The writing in and of itself is unique and if you're looking for a winding adjective heavy love poem (that doesn't involve cheesy dicks and candlesticks) then this isn't quite that, It's not the usual fare if only because it's so darn hilarious, Frustrating oh yes because you and the rest of the cast want to bash the two lovestruck loons' heads together but hilarious, And there's plot! Not heavy (this is after all just the beginning of a series) but enough to keep the story flowing forward, It focuses on introducing you to the characters within the story before it gets going, I love Sam and his friends dearly and the relationships within the book (from friendship to mentors to family to love) just tug at every single heartstring I own.
