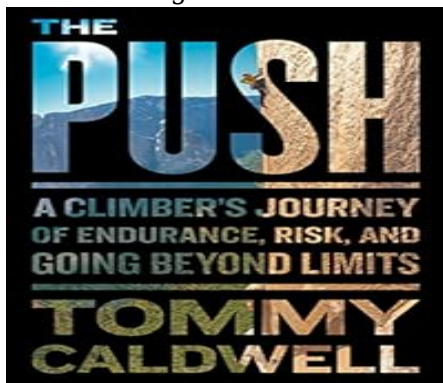


The Push: A Climber's Journey of Endurance, Risk, and Going Beyond Limits By Tommy Caldwell
