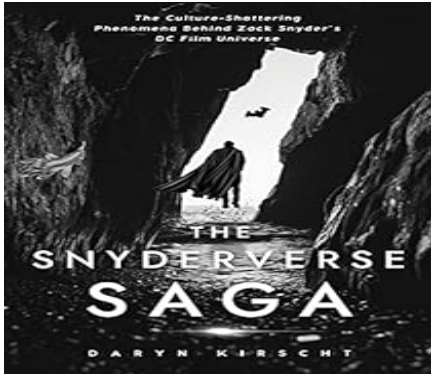


The Snyderverse Saga: The Culture-Shattering Phenomena Behind Zack Snyder's DC Film Universe

With a combination of cast and crew testimonials and documented milestones over the last decade Daryn brings together the drive and vision of what this historic film franchise was to deliver and the outside forces that pushed that vision down a vastly different path of both positive and negative results. As someone who was greatly in tune with the goings on of this film journey I was still hit with some surprises as well as given the opportunity to reminisce over the major events of the process.
