Was so close to cancelling and then the day after my birthday it arrived! And didn't disappoint!Not posting pics of the inside in case knowing my luck I spoil the game for someone. Immersive world it created: The only reason I still occasionally re visit the game is solely for the world and its beauty, For some reason I prefer Dark Horse but Titan Books has produced a flawless product, The gold tinged pages is a minor yet next level changing detail: Solidly made with a nice weight makes it feel like a premium product. Anyone familiar with Metal Gear will love the character sketches but it was the environments/world I was most interested in. The older I get the I appreciate the use of colour and lighting to give images a feeling of warmth or cold.
