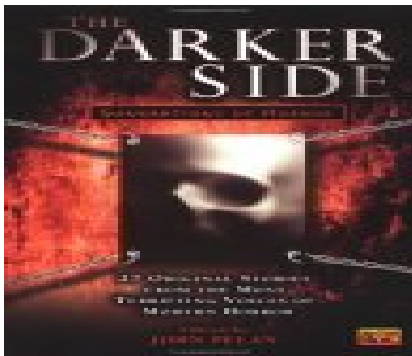

And Hell Came Down by Tim Lebbon. But for some reason just fell short. Then there were others that totally missed the mark. Flopped for lack of a better word. Not that that's a bad thing. I should get the bad out of the way first. In both cases continuity is the problem. But enough of that. So many of these authors deserve such praise. (Charlee Jacob in particular rocks the house. As usual. Better than its predecessor The Dark Side. Check this one out first. The Ocean by Poppy Z. The Darker Side: Generations of Horror (Darkside #2).
