for as Chang and Eng grew older each dreamed of a separate life despite the obvious risks that an operation would entail and each feared that the death of one would cause the death of the other. **The two books of jeu** Nor were their natures altogether harmonious for each was a highly individual person—Eng quiet contemplative and even-tempered;
