Not very often. **The old stones book** Despite the great ideas the book suffers from a lot of info dumps and weak characterisation and unfortunately I could not connect with the main characters and believe in their attraction to each other. **The Lost Stones crime news** I loved reading this book! The story was fantastic but I was torn between wanting the fiction to go away entirely so I could read it more like a research paper (I'm weird like that) and wishing the story was way way longer and more involved. **The secrets of lost stones book** One minute you're flying through the air amid bits of trailer house debris with the main character Ammon and the next you're on a plane following the next clue

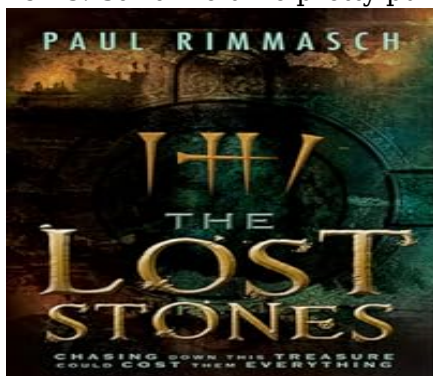
