There's speculation that the skeleton could be that of Jesus himself. **Crossbones clip art** Sound a little far fetched? Maybe at first glance but this plot is based

on actual facts and events. **Crossbones undertale** The James ossuary in Israel the tombs at Massada etc etc. **Crossbones underswap** This book is very reminiscent of something that would be written by a James Rollins or Dan Brown: **Cross bones book** Even the latest Robin Cook book has a similar theme: an ancient finding shrouded in mystery that could turn long standing modern religious dogma
