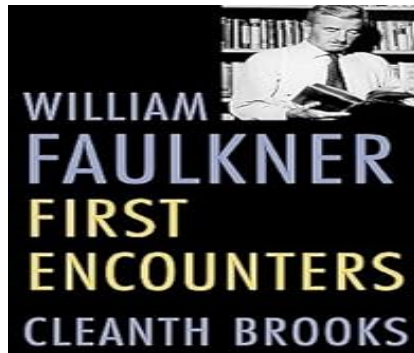


William faulkner short stories
