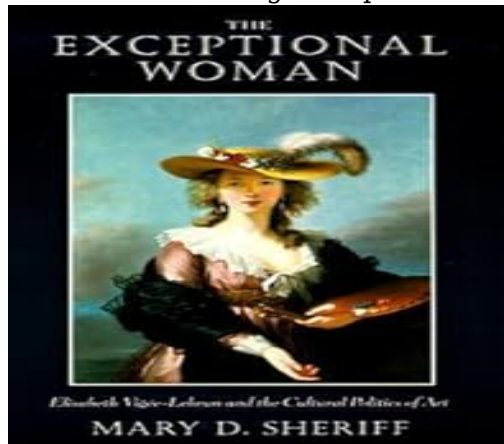


The Exceptional Woman: Elisabeth Vigée-Lebrun and the Cultural Politics of Art By Mary D. Sheriff
