

Psyren, Vol. 5: Visions By Toshiaki Iwashiro You think you're so powerful but there are some things only a worm can see! As a highlight we meet the star commanders! Dolkey was interesting but Shiner is so much better! And now I can't wait for them to fight more! **BOTTOM LINE:** They get better and better. paperback I really like that this manga's answer to what kind of people could survive suddenly being thrust into a post-apocalyptic world with only the benefit of new psionic powers is 'well. But on the bright side at least they're self-aware enough to recognize it's weird their conscience doesn't pang at them killing humanoid presenting creatures? :DDDDD?' Don't take me wrong though.

And further information is supplied about W. This made me a little sad because the author had a lot to say about books he reads and I wanted to give him the benefit of the doubt that he has the taste to pull off a good story. Yet though either the pressure of his publisher or overabundance of characters to lasso a plot around Psyren falls into the broad demographic of drab shonen that doesn't impress me. I was at first impressed with the characters fixing time in the past present and present future but that quickly waned after the characters had less of a reason to do it more for the sake of the plot than for themselves. The character models and designs are all really sharp and cool but didn't add much more to the story and that's the story that was squeezed between explosions that took up whole and chapters. It had potential all the way through to elaborate on some interesting storylines yet the final result is so top heavy from its characters it's hard to say any of them were worth reading. Also this story has really excellent fight scenes like I am the worst about getting bored with fights (reasons why Bleach slides lower and lower down my list of shonen I bother picking up from the library) but these ones keep me consistently interested, Inside the bomb shelter they find preserved newspapers and video recordings, These documents help them to understand how and when the future of the world falls into chaos, They find that the end of the world is only a year and a half away and an organization called W: I thought this book was action packed and thrilling! You get to see a more serious side of Kirisaki and you get to see him get angry, Kirisaki's character is very easy going and he doesn't have a wide range of emotions, Seeing him get angry and passionate about something was very refreshing. This book also left on a cliffhanger.

So I am excited to read the next one! I would recommend this book to people who like manga and action books: paperback I thought the previous volume pretty cool but this one is the cherry on top! Pretty much events revolve around the group fighting Dolkey and his patrol officers. I loved seeing Ageha gain some control and how Oboro's motivation was just to see what would happen: Another perfectly paced entry in the ongoing story of Psyren. The end of the volume promises interesting developments and an intriguing possible change in tone and/or direction, paperback Volume 5 introduced Yoshina's improved skill and a ranking system within the Star commanders: Unfortunately it seems as though Mochizuki had a bit of a dark edge with his Cure ability that I hope gets worked out and prevents him from going over the edge: paperback A video recording shows a dark vision of the future.

Except all of the action is Bleach and none of the thinking is the Matrix: Yet

the mystery that's initially set up of the contemporary world being so different from the Psyren wasteland was really compelling and hooked me to the story: And the semblance of characterization that was there consisted more of archetypes than substantial players of the game: The severe lack of motive is something I found made the books really flat overall. Yet it sets up a whole mess of characters you don't care if Ageha saves or not, Everyone he's fighting to save he shared a comedic moment brodown boob grab or info dump in response to a question. The books never give the characters time to simmer and build on each other and the point of the series seems moot if that's what we're given, I would say it's worth reading if you're looking for something different in shonen even if it isn't super different: But it certainly didn't show me that the genre has mature or thoughtful stories to tell but just gave me more pointy-haired high school sword flingers saving the world. {site\_link} Ageha Sakurako Kirisaki Hiryu and Oboro are transported back to the world of Psyren: Once there I love this cast pop stars with a penchant for experimenting on chimera creatures and all. 4 stars paperback Psyren takes place a carefully constructed world and its overarching plot continually builds chapter by chapter. Along the way a big revelation comes to light we learn more about Psi powers and their uses where many of Ageha's friends are ruthlessly killed: E Ageha Sakurako and the others must battle their way to freedom, But even if they escape can they really fight fate and alter that treacherous future?
