earlier work though he returned to the themes later, **René magritte death** Magritte died of pancreatic cancer on August 15 1967 and was interred in Schaarbeek Cemetery Brussels, **Rene magritte kindir** Popular interest in Magritte's work rose considerably in the 1960s and his imagery has influenced pop minimalist and conceptual art. **Arts Photography René magritte museum** In 2005 he came 9th in the Walloon version of De Grootste Belg (The Greatest Belgian); in the Flemish version he was 18th.
