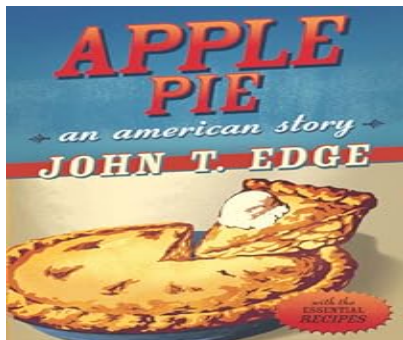
Apple pie kipling
