recherche For some reason I tend to be much more receptive to the message when I can actually bring myself to care about the story or the characters however unsympathetic they may be.

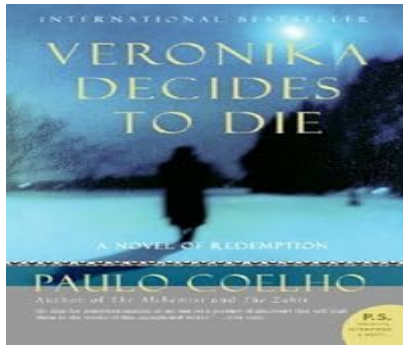
