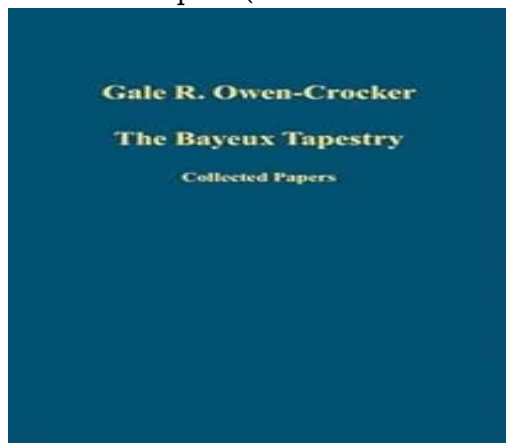


The Bayeux Tapestry: Collected Papers (Variorum Collected Studies) By Gale R. Owen-Crocker
