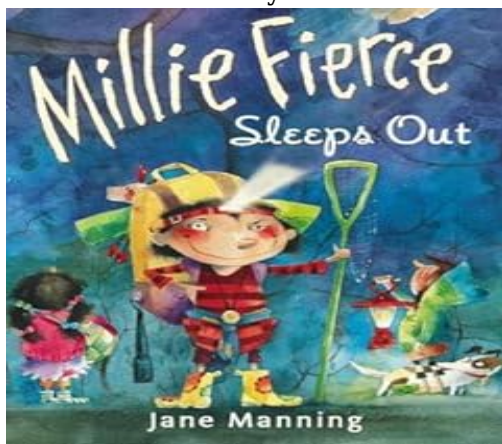


Millie Fierce Sleeps outxe

As you walk by this book your eyes are drawn to the bright colors and the delightful drawing of Millie Fierce and she is going to Sleep Out! Jane Manning has once again drawn the children's attention and they learned a good lesson without even knowing it! Millie who is known for her bad temper has been trying really really hard all summer to be good and she is about to be rewarded for her good behavior. **Book Millie Fierce Sleeps outdoor** Not only is the book a lot of fun (Millie's sleep out sounds like a real blast!) but it also teaches young readers about self-control and the importance of standing up for oneself at the same time. **Millie Fierce Sleeps outmost** This kind of story can so easily be didactic and eye-rollingly obvious but Manning does a nice job of allowing Millie to be herself as she struggles to deal with disappointments and irritations. **Millie Fierce Sleeps Out booker** She's been so good in fact that she's going to have a campout in her backyard with her two very best friends! A perfect addition to a bookshelf filled with Fancy Nancy Eloise Olivia and Ladybug Girl. **Book Millie Fierce Sleeps outlook** --School Library Journal An unexpected Yeatsian lilt to Manning's writing (Millie frizzed out her hair and made the crazy eye) lifts the text out of the ordinary; her powers of observation set it apart too. **Millie Fierce Sleeps outyear** Why do people try to suppress spiritedness in girls rather than say help them learn to redirect it and learn to use it constructively and in contrast to boys who are allowed to just be fierce without censure most of the time when girls are criticized for the same behaviour? Why do people think it is OK to teach girls that it is wrong to state their preferences needs and wants - in this case labeling it 'fierceness' rather than assertiveness again in contrast to boys who are expected to just say what they need and want? (and where girls are often called 'bossy' rather than 'fierce' in this situation but where both are unfair). **Millie Fierce Sleeps outou** Why is it made exceptional when a little girl is finally 'allowed' to be fierce - in this case brave and protective and assertive? A boy protagonist would not work in this situation because he would have been allowed to have these behaviours for the whole book. **Millie Fierce Sleeps outside** 5 year old absolutely loved the pictures (particularly the expressions of the puppy)! This book is a wonderful way to explore our emotions- and the best ways to use them - because after all Sometimes it takes a little ferocity to set things right, **Millie Fierce Sleeps outus raffia** She is being allowed to have a tenting sleep over with her friends and we get excited as we plan what we are going to do. **Millie Fierce Sleeps outventure** My boys really thought this was a real neat idea and would love to have their friends over to sleep in the tent with them: **Book Millie Fierce Sleeps outdoor** We will see!
