Answer: Writing a few impressions on Budapest by Chico Buarque. **Budapest book cafe** A man this Chico who gets a high consideration in a country - Brazil - where another successful musician like Gilberto Gil spent five years playing the minister of Culture (and did some good things). **Budapest airport** This is a very clever novel written in a very personal style and I'm glad I picked up this book pretty much by choice in one of my usual Saturday expeditions scouring the second hand bookshops. **Budapest klinikken** An unusual novel yes but nonetheless related to other things I read in the past combining the introspection of Nooteboom with the magical realism of Borges in a plot that reminded me the Ringmaster's Daughter by Gaarder. **Budapest text** Whereas Gaarder wrote about a guy getting his living by selling to famous novelists beginnings and whole first chapters of stories to develop in successful books Buarque's José Costa is

a ghost writer or - as he puts it - an anonymous writer. **Budapest Literature fiction definition** José Costa is not the kind of man wearing a Guy Fawkes mask and thinking about blowing up the parliament in Brasilia at the frenzy chimes of Bat Macumba by the Os Mutantes. **Budapest klinikken** He's happy he's content of standing in the shadow while his associate Alvaro works on enlarging the portfolio of politicians bishops professors interested in having José writing their public speeches and essays. **Budapest book fountain** During a strange conference of these anonymous individuals at a ghostwriters conference Jose Costa/narrator observes "The whole thing was beginning to remind me of an alcoholics anonymous meeting whose participants suffered not from alcoholism but anonymity. **Budapest nonfiction** English What falling in love with a country with a language can make with a man?
