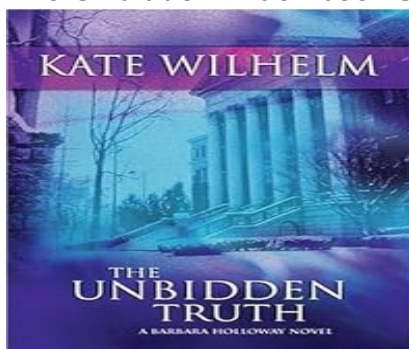

It is chock full of crazy seemingly unrelated clues. Certainly kept me turning pages. I do have a question for you other readers though. Who was Ramon? And H. L. The defendant is Carol Fredricks. It is here that Barbara discovers something odd. Carol was a foster child most of her life. Carole can't remember anything from before she was eight. Barbara latches on the situation like a dog with a bone. It appears that much is against her. I am a pianist myself classical not world-class.
