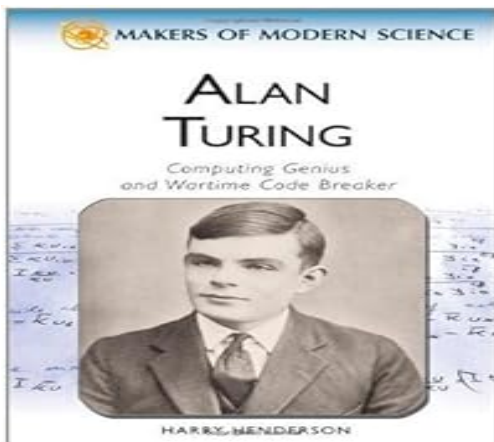


Alan Turing: Computing Genius and Wartime Code Breaker (Makers of Modern Science) By Harry Henderson
