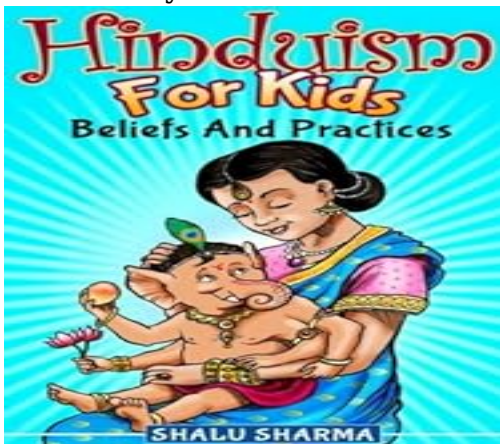


Hinduism for kids facts
