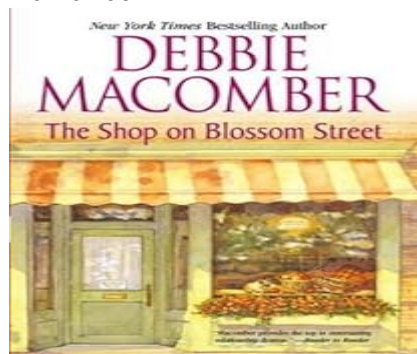


The Shop on Blossom Street (Blossom Street, #1) By Debbie Macomber
