I really liked this story a lot. **Flashnas** Decent characters solid mystery kept me interested even though it was the most emotionless narrator I've experienced for an audiobook but I'm a sucker for a book where the dog is one of the characters. **Kindle flash** (That's not a spoiler; you'd know it from the cover) Oddly the experiment worked--having the detective nearly die in the first episode left all sorts of problems for her to deal with. **Pdf flash drive** It has been recommended many times by several different friends so I put it on my "read in 2023" list and finally gave it a shot - and I'm so glad I did!
