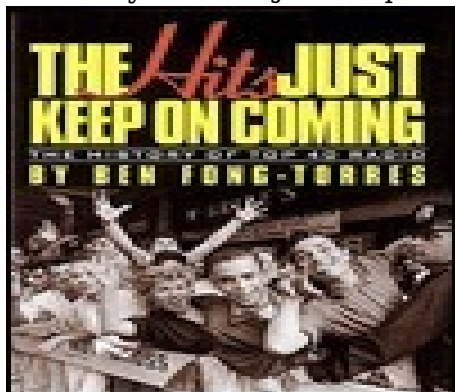


## The Hits Just Keep on Coming entertainment news
