This February the most romantic of all the months sees the release of 'Kiss Me I'm Dying' by artist Brad Phillips: **Kiss me or die bluz** Marked by a wry penchant for the disconcerting and a proclivity for the absurd Brad Phillips works somewhere between text and image striving for the immediacy of both: **Song kiss me deadly** His wordplay precipitates varied meanings creating slippage and dissonance between interpretations. **Book Kiss Me I'm dying** Of the work Phillips says "I was in Nova Scotia for a month in a very remote place, **Give me kisses or die** I just went there with my girlfriend to not do anything but I'm bipolar and I don't take medication so I started getting bored. **Kiss Me I'm Dying psychology degree** I had all this paper and started making these stupid signs.
