Nitro is adamant that he is going to protect and care for Peter and his pup but Nitro is positive that Peter will reject him once the full reality of his new world sinks in. However as the shifters were emancipated by the witches the Highborn became a radical group who hunt down omegas kidnap them force-breed them with their alphas and raise the pups to be warriors in their army. Unexpected Heat (Omega Really?! #1) Lone wilderness wolf succumbs to mating urge with a human in the big city This novella combines decent prose with a formulaic story introducing relatively bland characters and taking them through a basic human omega mpreg story. The setting and story idea were intriguing - a human omega goes into heat once a year and at 25 finally hooks up with an Alpha wolf shifter resulting in a male pregnancy. Who knew a male could get pregnant and deliver a pup? It was great to see Peter not believing Nitro at first as he's talking about pregnancy and shifters and Peter's thoughts are that he allowed a man who was unbalanced into his home and plots his escape. So (sorry guys gotta spoiler this part) if an author tells us in the book that there are ass-babies DO NOT DELIVER THE BABY BY C-SECTION!!!! What a freaking tease! Here I was all excited about getting to read one of the rare ass-babies mpreg stories but I was DENIED! JL was NOT happy about this turn of events. I read the blurbs for the future books in this series and might give it another chance although I'm very disappointed that the omega MC who escapes the Highborn in the next book Sweet Heat is not Nitro's brother. That was a lot better so I'm very glad I started there or I might have decided not to continue the series if I started with this book first, There was a really nice pacing to the story and everything flowed really well but there were a couple of spelling errors in the first chapter or so, The blurb for 'Unexpected Heat' pulled me in and I was curious about not only the new-to-me author but the world building. I couldn't wait to find out how Peter couldn't have known what he was and I was supremely curious about a man with the very sexy name of Nitro: The initial meeting and resulting sex between Nitro and Peter is scorching: Unfortunately once Nitro passes the point of no return so to speak is when he realizes that Peter is a rare omega and has no idea what he is, After freaking out (and running away - bad Nitro bad) Nitro returns to the city tracks Peter down and confirms he's pregnant, Now comes the hard part of explaining what he is which naturally Peter thinks is nuts and that Nitro is insane. To be honest I believe I would have responded exactly the same way if I'd been in Peter's position: Nevertheless these two are going to have to get through this and come to some sort of understanding for there are dangers in Nitro's world: In Peter's new world there are only alphas and omegas the dominants and the submissivees. A male shifter can't impregnate a human but on very rare occasions a human male can impregnate an omega: This explains how Peter came to be but it's still terrifying to know he's spent his whole life thinking he was one thing only to discover he's something else entirely. Although seeing these two men looking at onesies was enough to warm my heart and make me smile: But a girl is possible considering you're half human I suppose. For years we served as familiars to the most powerful witches. She came to love her creations so much that she created omegas so we could reproduce and wouldn't be alone: "The Highborn is a faction of shifters that had begun a rebellion against the witches using them as familiars: Nitro is beyond grateful that he found his mate before they did: I adored the world the author created as the basic tenets of the genre are there but she made them unique enough to be different and fascinating: I'm hoping to see them again in future installments but I suspect each of these novellas are independent of one another: I am so looking forward to reading the next book in the series as there is still so much for me to learn: The Alpha's resulting

pursuit capture convincing escape/rescue and hosting of the omega is described with a bit of underlying shifter plot and conflict, While some of the writing flowed well overall the characters plot developments and relationship fell relatively flat, The story and characters weren't particularly enticing but it does go through the entire mpreg process from surprise mating to parenthood and bonding: There is a bit of sizzle here and there but this will mostly appeal to fans of simple coverage the entire mpreg experience from beginning to end. But for a few short days every year the heat takes over and the undeniable urge to mate draws him to San Francisco and out of his self-imposed solitude, He's willing to deal with all the foul odors congestion and general misery for some bump and grind action, Computer programmer Peter Callaghan likes his quiet boring life. But like every year since his seventeenth birthday a rampaging need to screw every guy with a heartbeat takes over, During this time he finds he can climb out of his shell and be a normal horny and slightly sarcastic twenty-five-year-old, Peter knows the hulking man with a biker's name will go down in history as his hottest bang but Peter gets more than he bargained for. When the man shows up several weeks later raving about pregnancies and mythological creatures Peter realizes he's being held captive by a crazy person. After escaping Peter is chased down by a rabid wolf and Nitro pops out of nowhere to rescue him sporting fur fangs and claws. As Peter witnesses the unimaginable he realizes Nitro might be telling the truth about more than him being a shape-changing beast, Having been thrust into a mysterious and bizarre world Peter is forced to rely on Nitro and something long buried inside Peter begins to awaken: But could they possibly have a future together? ***Notice*** This 40k novella contains material suited for adults only, 5 stars I haven't read much mpreg at all and the start to this book was fun and heated, Because with both Peter and Nitro on the prowl it is all about the heat: Peter is a quiet guy and basically blends into the background until the same time every year where he clearly can break out of his shell: Nitro has been living on his own for years away from his pack as he was betrayed by his very own brother: Although Nitro realizes exactly what has taken place Peter is clueless, It was well done as Peter falls ill and then Nitro shows up: Nitro is full of regret that he left Peter on his own and has to come to claim his mate. Unexpected Heat (Omega Really?! #1) This wasn't half bad! The characters were engaging and the plot was interesting: I need to see if the author expands on the world building and characters' back stories. The author piqued my interest with their take on the origin of shifters and now I need to know more: First this story is in need of an editor or at the very least a proofreader. There were quite a few misspelled words and some of the sentences needed to be structured differently so they would make more sense, A couple of plot holes here and there but they were minor and didn't really detract from the story. Second one of my biggest pet peeves is when an author misuses homophones, Throughout the entire book there was the the misuse of the passed/past homophones which is weird because they got the peeked/peaked/piqued homophones right, Those of us who read mpreg books know what to expect and what we hope the author will deliver (heh). So if you like shifter-fluff-with-mpreg stories this is pretty middle of the road, Who knows it might hit all of your buttons and you end up loving it. I've read a lot of Omega-verse Sterek/Steter fan fiction and I like that uncontrolled lust aspects of Heat, I liked watching both Nitro and Peter separately on the prowl and their explosive first time together: This author might be a little more practiced (and better) at the porn aspects since the sex was hawt: But after that first meeting the dialogue got very formulaic and stilted, While Peter said he had a hard time dealing with this new information we didn't see or feel him go through those emotions. But again as the plot went on I wanted to feel more emotions: Instead it felt a little like a PWP that had too much plot. I kept reading it as 'Nee-tro' or 'Nico' and found it very frustrating. Like most mpreg the pregnant male freaks out and then slowly falls in love with the alpha male: There's no drama other than Nitro's twin wanting to steal Nitro's mate, The events leading up

to that confrontation are practically non-existent, There's no additional characters no build up very little background. It seems to be missing a lot of elements that make up a great story. It was ok I plan to read the rest of the series but after that I am sure I can easily forget this series[1]
