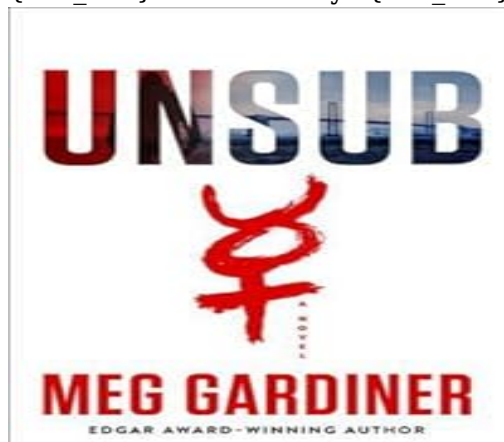

Why now? Where has he been all this time? What is his end game? The stakes are high as more bodies are found and Caitlin finds herself getting deeper and deeper in the investigations as the Prophet appears to be getting under her skin. **Unsubdivided** Detective Caitlin Hendrix is then called to a murder scene where two bodies are found brutally murdered and though it appears impossible she immediately recognizes the murderer's signature: The Prophet has returned. **Unsubscribed** In addition the characters are so real they jumped off the page in a way that made me feel as though I was right there with them every second of the way - so much so that my pulse was racing wicked fast and I was completely spent by the time I got to the
