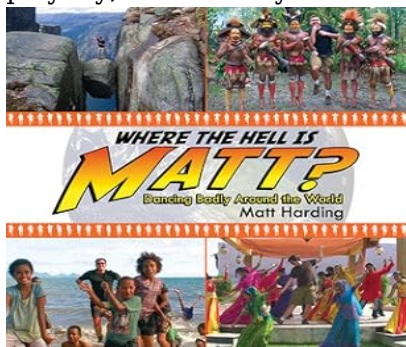


Las Vegas Madam By Matt Harding
