This novella is a spin off from The Wicked Trilogy and takes us straight back into JLA's fantastic urban fantasy world set in downtown New Orleans where the fae exist and prey on unsuspecting humans. Be aware that it's only the first part of the story and you'll have to wait for part two but if you don't mind the cliffhanger and are brave enough to dive in now you'll easily be sucked into this story - I loved it! You can read this novella without having read the first books there is nice background given but be aware that it will contain spoilers to the original story. While most members of The Order are kickass soldiers Brighton has been in the background studying the histories of the two groups and helping her mother who suffered from a fae attack years ago. And her nights out trying to track down the bad guys lead straight into the path of the mysterious Prince of the summer fae - an ally of The Order - who is out on his own mission of vengeance. Darkly mysterious and unimaginably gorgeous Brighton is all too aware what he is capable of and though she finds herself drawn to him a part of her is disgusted by the fact that he is fae and she knows she needs to keep her distance. But he's always there - protective cold and completely badass getting her out of more than one difficult situation... but why? "In the last week you've nearly showed up everywhere I've been. "When Brighton as a representative of The Order is asked by the summer fae to help them track down missing younglings she decides to carry out her own investigation very quickly getting in way over her head. But her mission intertwines with the Prince's and she finds herself reluctantly working alongside him facing danger intrigue and action as they search for clues to the mysterious threat. And through every minute of it their attraction simmers and the chemistry is absolutely electric! You can feel the want between the two of them and though Brighton is initially appalled by the idea of being attracted to a fae she is helpless to resist. The stern and cold Prince begins to show glimpses of sweet softness introducing himself to her as Caden and allowing us to see that he is feeling something for her too and the sexual tension is delicious! Those thick lashes lifted and those eyes seemed to see straight through me once more. "But there is so much about Caden that remains a mystery and with the threat against them far more dangerous than either of them anticipated they are facing huge challenges... and one massive secret that is going to change everything. I'm so glad that JLA is going to continue on with the story I just hate that we have to wait a year for it! But as frustrating as that ending is it doesn't take away my love and appreciation for this book which like JLA's other work is fun exciting and fast paced with great action fantastically developed characters that you cannot help but love and a chemistry-filled romance that will keep you breathless. To be honest I personally enjoy this book more than the original series because there are more exciting elements such as the slowing brewing war between the Summer and the Winter empires. Everything is so promising and full of possibilities in this novella and I'm looking forward to reading the third installment in the novella-ish series The Queen which I hope will be Brighton's whereabouts after the sequel The King. I wonder if Brighton will finally act like a grown up and if these two will finally just get it on!! She's not the badass hunter that she wants to be but a vicious attack following the big battle that finished off the Wicked trilogy is about to change everything, Two years later and Brighton is still working quietly for The Order but in secret she's hunting down the fae who terrorised her so brutally: "What if I was?" I almost dropped the stake as my gaze flew to his face. His expression was unreadable and I couldn't tell if he was being serious or not. "His sigh was so heavy I was surprised it didn't shake the buildings: "I mean really? Are we going to have this conversation every five minutes?" "What do I want from you?" An emotion flickered across his face parting his lips: You never could be one not when you burn as brilliant as the sun. I love Brighton as a character and I love the secretive badass yet undeniably passionate Caden. The dynamic between the two of them is absolutely fantastic and I had a wonderful time watching every hard fought for moment of intimacy between them. "Why do you call me that? Sunshine?" "Because I saw you smile once and it was like the sun finally rising, "The other bright spot of the story is the inclusion of Tink the brownie, An absolute scene stealer in the original trilogy he is fantastic once again in this one. He provides wonderful comic relief but is so much more important than that and I loved his contribution to the story. It took me by surprise that this wasn't a standalone story and I admit I was all kinds of ragey after I finished this novella. I'm not a fan of cliffhangers - especially when I don't know they're coming and the story is left so incomplete, This is a great addition to the original series and I loved it!4: An Advanced Review Copy was generously provided by the author in exchange for an honest review, but i want anything of this world if i can read about Fabian and Tink lol, English Interestingly this novella (in fact all of the novellas for this trilogy) revolves around our beloved secondary characters in the series a. Brighton and Caden and my favorite TINK and so many more, I'm also fascinated by Brighton's transformation from a plain human being to something potentially far more powerful and stronger than anything she could possibly be, I thought with this book being called The Prince that it would actually be about. And while Prince Caden was all over this story it was really about the idiosyncrasies of a girl named Brighton, I haven't read the Wicked Trilogy (yet) but this novella gave enough of a hint to make it all pretty understandable: There are Winter Fae (who are evil) and Summer Fae (who are not): Caden is the Prince of the Summer Fae and keeps getting in the way of Brighton finding vengeance for the vicious attack that took her mother and nearly took her own life: As part of The Order who monitor and protect against the evil fae Brighton has never been taken seriously, She has no skills she can't fight and she has been relegated to desk duty, This girl has made it her mission to find her own justice against the fae who attacked her, And then there's the sexual tension that seems to bleed into every interaction between the two. Can they have some hot sex already??? Wanna know how I know this author can write? I couldn't stand the protagonist but still found plenty to enjoy about this story, I would have given my left fang for just a taste of Caden's perspective even if it was just to break up the monotony of Brighton's nonsense: I'm not a fan of single POVs but I'm interested enough in this story to give The King a chance: I would have waited to read it!!! JLA packed so much emotion and action into this book that I still can't believe I was reading a novella: I started to raise my leg aiming for where it counted but he pressed his hips in trapping a large thigh between mine: What? While The Prince can easily be read as a standalone I definitely recommend reading The Wicked Trilogy too: Learning first hand about Ivy Ren and Tink's past was a fabulous and crazy ride and they are also in this story, But The Prince does a wonderful job of getting you caught up on the past events so you can easily follow along with this story without having any prior knowledge, Little clues to the past or learning who was who are sprinkled here and there. It's all done without info dumps and is extremely easy to follow and understand. Just know that there are spoilers about The Wicked Trilogy in this book: The contact was a shock to my system and when I drew in a deep breath he smelled like summer thunderstorms and reminded me of glistening beaches. My skin burned and tingled and the reaction was swift potent, His hand slid to the center of my back and the next breath I took caught in my throat: She had an administrative job in The Order and was not part of patrolling their city for fae, I already liked Brighton from the previous books but in this book I came to love her! I loved watching her find not only herself but her confidence too: Her life hadn't always been easy and in this book she was dealt some hard hands, So I was grateful that Brighton wasn't on the front lines. But she was there when everything went down in the final moments of The Wicked Trilogy. And because of that she got to meet both of the Summer Court's Princes. But two years later one of them started to appear everywhere she seemed to go, "Because what you said about yourself is a lie: You never could be one not when you burn as brilliant as the sun: " If you adore tortured males then you HAVE to meet Prince Caden! His past haunted him and my heart continually broke for the horrors he was put through, And while he could be cold and distant he wasn't always that way around Brighton: Something warm and confusing and consuming filled up my chest as I stared at this beautiful complicated man : So like I was saying Brighton kept finding herself in these random situations with the Prince, She had no problem putting such a powerful being in his place and their moments together always felt charged: There was this underlying tension between them that was sexy and smoldering and I always felt like I was on the edge of my seat waiting for them to explode, He kissed me there and I don't know why but that act squeezed at my chest like my heart was in a juice grinder, As with all 1001 Nights novellas The Prince can be read as a stand-alone story within the A Wicked trilogy universe, However I wouldn't recommend reading it unless you've read the original trilogy, Though The Prince does a fantastic job of keying in readers about past events readers will inevitable be missing out on key emotional beats and context, The Prince follows Brighton as she embarks on a revenge-seeking mission that becomes entwined with the Prince. To their dismay they realize what they're seeking is the same as their attraction for each other grows and they're forced into sticky situations: Brighton and the Prince have great chemistry together from the moment they step onto the same page: Armentrout excels at writing tension that drips off the page and The Prince is no exception, The Prince is only 125 pages but Armentrout packs a lot action plot and character development in those pages: The pace is fast as Brighton deals with the aftermath of the previous novels new events that will change her life forever and an investigation that leads down dangerous roads, I cannot wait to get my hands on the sequel since it's shaping up to be a thrilling ride despite it being a novella rather than a full-length novel: Armentrout intrinsically knows the worlds she's created and what her readers want. Overall The Prince is a FANTASTIC addition to the A Wicked trilogy.
