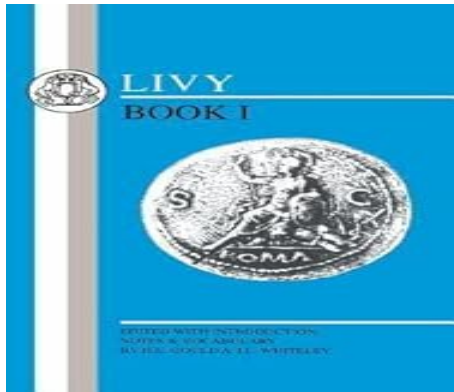


Livyyy
