

Maimonides' on Coitus: A New Parallel (Medical Works of Moses Maimonides, 11) (Arabic and English Edition) By Gerrit Bos

Moses Maimonides' On Coitus was composed at the request of an unknown high-ranking official who asked for a regimen that would be easy to adhere to and that would increase his sexual potency as he had a large number of slave girls. The present edition by Gerrit Bos contains the original Arabic text three medieval Hebrew translations two Latin versions from the same translation (edited by Charles Burnett) and a Slavonic translation (edited by Will Ryan and Moshe Taube): It is safe to assume that it was popular in Jewish and non-Jewish circles as it survives in several manuscripts both in Arabic and Judaeo-Arabic, Maimonides' on Coitus: A New Parallel (Medical Works of Moses Maimonides 11) (Arabic and English Edition)
