The vanished cast 2020 He is about to return because of some incident with Japanese authorities but then one of the paragraphs is told from his mother's perspective (something along the lines: "I knew he was coming back and was eager for his return") but then the next paragraph goes back to the third person and Embon's preparations to leave.

Book the vanished Ok I am not an expert on Korean culture but the words are very English-like: for example 'university campus' 'goodies' (really?) and there is a part where one characters tells her daughter 'I'm so sorry honey'.

The Vanished epublising The last part of the book does focus heavily on Embon's involvement with the movement but I felt some points were too convenient; how he easily reconnected with his university friends and left everything behind; how easily he was accepted among rebels considering his background etc.

Book the vanishing half Though we all know that Korea was eventually free from Japanese rule the book ends many years before that and no indication whether Embon continued with the fight after all that happened.

Kim Embon was born into a noble family. He was accepted to Hokkaido Imperial University in Japan. Embon was arrested and interrogated by the Japanese. He was released when they discovered who his family was. I enjoyed Ms. Bradley's descriptive writing style. The customs became apparent without an obvious explanation. This story was so engaging that it was over too soon. I believe this book to be professionally edited. I didn't find any grammar punctuation or spelling errors. There was no sexual content and no profane language. I rate this book 4 out of 4 stars. Bradley's will to share Korean history is evident. Personally I learned a lot from The Vanished. ignorance and poverty. The Vanished: A Novel Amazing. Emotional. Tragic. This is the story of Embon and eventually all Korea. It's so complex that words simply evade me. I loved it. Every part of it. The new mother names her son Embon. They would not hesitate in imposing strict rules. Besides the invaders believe they are above world opinions. But he had no choice then. Meanwhile Embon is still a naive royal. Until he meets his fellow Koreans there. Embon's perspective begins to shape up at a new level. The plot of The Vanished takes new twists and turns too. Some of the aspects that bothered me were: 1. The synopsis. This takes us to the second point. 2. There were way too many characters. 3. Lack of plot coherence and irrelevant details. For example Mr. Poor editing. But at

this point that girl had not been introduced. An epilogue would have been very helpful. Pejay Bradley
