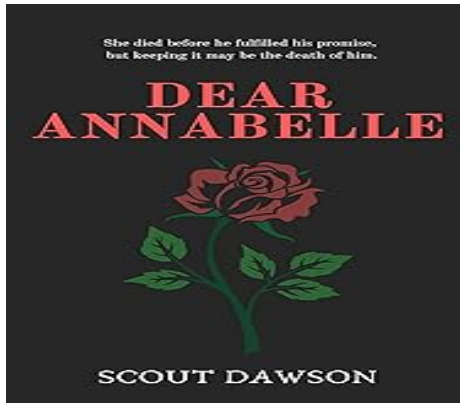


Fiction Dear annabelle 3
