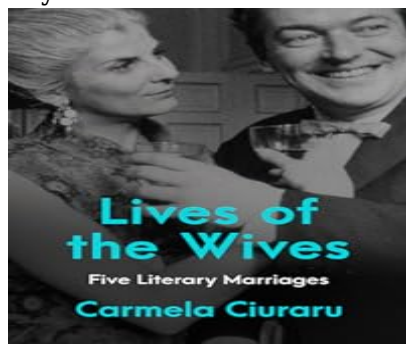


Nonfiction lives of the wives book
