

Familiar Stranger (Dark Enchantments #2) By Michele Hauf **Familiar Stranger Science Fiction fantasy books** There was some action and intrigue and a nice little romance going alongside but for me it just lacked something that I can't quite put my finger on and hence didn't have a 'WOW factor'. **Familiar Stranger fictional** I also felt the ending seemed a bit rushed and suddenly 'crept up on you!'
