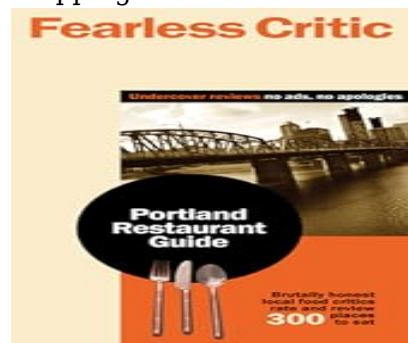


The Fearless Critic Portland Restaurant Guide By Robin Goldstein
