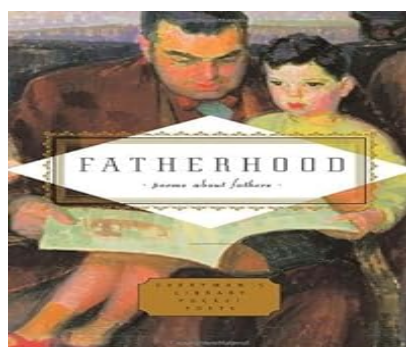


Fatherhood: poems about fathers (Everyman's Library Pocket Poets) By Carmela Ciuraru
