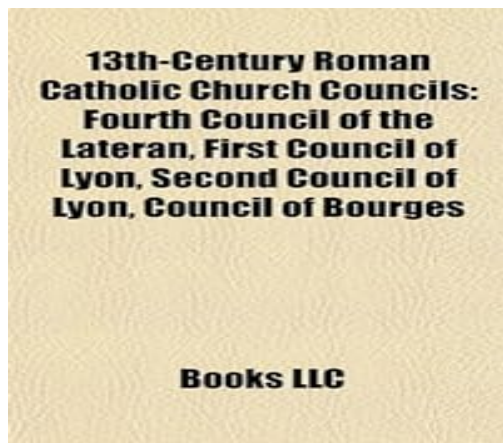

Among others who attended the council were James I of Aragon the ambassador of the Emperor Michael VIII Palaiologos with members of the Greek clergy and the ambassadors of Abaq Khan of the Ilkhanate. In addition to Aragon which James represented in person representatives of the kings of Germany England Scotland France the Spains and Sicily were present with procurators also representing the kingdoms of Norway Sweden Hungary Bohemia the realm of Dacia and the duchy of Poland,

The council was attended by some bishops sixty abbots and more than a thousand prelates or their procurators among whom were the representatives of the universities, Due to the great number of attendees those who had come to Lyon without being specifically summoned were given leave to depart with the blessing of God and of the Pope, Thomas Aquinas had been summoned to the council but died en route at Frosinone.
